

# Corporate Award of Excellence

## General

The **Corporate Award of Excellence** bestows distinction on a team of engineers/geoscientists or an outstanding engineering/geoscience project that has had, or will have, a significant positive impact on society, industry, and/or engineering/geoscience, and recognizes engineering/geoscience achievements involving New Brunswick professionals.

## Nomination

Nominations for the Corporate Award of Excellence must be submitted to the Awards Committee in writing on the appropriate APEGNB form and must be supported by at least two (2) members. Nominations must be approved by the organization responsible for the project or the team of engineers/geoscientists being nominated.

## Eligibility Criteria

The nominee must meet the following requirements:

- Be an outstanding engineering/geoscience project that was conceived, designed and executed with significant input by New Brunswick professional engineers/geoscientists or a team where the majority of engineer/geoscientist members (at least 50%) were Canadians registered as professional members (P.Eng./P.Geo.) with APEGNB. If a group of New Brunswick engineers or geoscientists was involved in a project as part of a larger, multi-professional team, they must have had a significant say in the conception, design, and execution of the project.
- Be an outstanding project or team of engineers/geoscientists that has had a significant impact on society, industry and/or engineering/geoscience.\*
- The majority (at least 50%) of the team members must reside in New Brunswick.
- Projects must have been completed within two years prior to the year of nomination of the award or the project team must have made a significant contribution during this period.

*\*Members of the APEGNB Council are not considered eligible for an award until a period of at least six months has elapsed from the completion date of their term of office.*

## Selection

The Awards Committee will consider each project/team on its own merits and recommend to Council the conferring of the Award. Consideration is given to the magnitude of impact a project or team of engineers/geoscientists has had on society, industry and/or engineering/geoscience. The Company selected must employ registered professionals who are resident in New Brunswick. Recipients will be notified by telephone and in writing.

## Presentation

The Award will be presented to the senior manager/owner who is registered with APEGNB at an appropriate function during the Annual Meeting.

## Award

Trophy engraved with recipient's name.

## Promotion

Award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by APEGNB which may include:

- Pictures of award recipient and biography printed in Annual magazine
- Pictures of award recipient to appear in newsletter—Engenuity
- Coverage of award recipient in New Brunswick newspapers

## Commencement

The first **Award of Excellence** was presented in 1985. The award does not have to be conferred on an annual basis.

A **Impact on Society, and/or Industry** (30%) – This section should include the number of individuals whose lives have been impacted by an engineering/geoscience project or team of engineers/geoscientists as well as the magnitude of the positive impact created by a project or team of professionals to New Brunswick's economic and social well-being.

B **Ingenuity** (20%) – This section should address the ingenuity displayed in the conception, design and execution of the engineering/geoscience project or by the team of professionals, whether it can be applied to future projects or by other teams of professionals, and whether it has advanced the field of engineering/geoscience.

C **Project Complexity** (20%) – This section should address the complexity of the project and/or the problems overcome by the team of professionals, and the future applicability of the solutions used to overcome the problems.

D **Economic and Environmental Impacts** (20%) – This section should address the magnitude of economic growth created by the project or team of professionals, as well as the economic benefits and cost effectiveness, and whether this was achieved in a manner that promoted sustainable development and/or minimized environmental impacts.

E **Client Expectations** (10%) – This section should address the extent to which the project or the work provided by a team of professionals met client expectations, and whether it was completed in accordance with budget and completion date estimates.

F **Personal and General Information**—This section should include corporate background information, biographies of team members, honours, media clippings, client testimonials and other relevant information

*Note: You must provide a letter of support for the nomination from the client/owner.*
