Available to New Brunswick residents of aboriginal ancestry who have been accepted into an engineering program at either the University of New Brunswick (Fredericton or Saint John) or Université de Moncton. The scholarship may be used to help offset tuition, textbooks, transportation and/or living expenses.

Field of Study Engineering - Full time or part time for the equivalent of one academic term.

Value \$3000 (renewable for up to five years based on academic performance).

Frequency Offered yearly

Duration Up to five years

Criteria

- New Brunswick resident of First Nations (Status or Non-Status)
- accepted into an engineering program at University of New Brunswick (Fredericton or Saint John) or Université de Moncton.
- require financial assistance to pursue education

If you are already receiving partial funding from other sources, you may still apply to cover additional educational and living expenses.
