

# Honorary Membership

## General

Council may confer **Honorary Membership** in the Association upon any person who, through his/her own initiative and leadership, has rendered eminent service to the professions and has been elected to honorary membership by unanimous vote of Council. Honorary Members are exempt from payment of dues and shall not be entitled to practise unless they are registered or licenced.

## Nomination

Nominations for Honorary Membership must be submitted to the Awards Committee in writing on the appropriate APEGNB form and must be supported by at least six (6) members.

## Selection

Awards committee to consider each nominee on his/her merits and receive unanimous support of Council before conferring of the Award. Recipients will be notified by telephone and in writing.

## Presentation

The Award will be presented at an appropriate function during the Annual Meeting. The presentation will be delivered in a manner in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

## Award

Trophy engraved with recipient's name.

## Promotion

Award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by APEGNB which may include:

- Pictures of award recipient and biography printed in Annual magazine
- Pictures of award recipient to appear in newsletter--Engenuity
- Coverage of award recipient in New Brunswick newspapers

## Commencement

The first **Honorary Membership** was presented in 1999. The award does not have to be conferred on an annual basis and no more than one per year.
