

Outstanding Student Award

General

The **Outstanding Student Award** bestows distinction on an outstanding New Brunswick undergraduate engineering/geoscience student and recognizes exceptional contributions to societal issues.

Nomination

Nominations for the Outstanding Student Award must be submitted to the Awards Committee in writing on the appropriate APEGNB form and must be supported by at least two (2) APEGNB members.

Eligibility Criteria

The nominee must meet the following requirements:

- Be enrolled, and in good standing, in a University of New Brunswick or Université de Moncton undergraduate engineering/geoscience program at the time of nomination.
- As a student, through employment, volunteer or personal initiatives in New Brunswick or on behalf of New Brunswick, had a major positive impact on the image of New Brunswick's/Canada's engineering or geoscience professions.

Selection

The Awards Committee will consider each nominee on his/her merits and make recommendations to Council on the conferring of the Award. Consideration is given to evidence of outstanding contributions to societal issues through community involvement, outstanding achievements, leadership in the professions at the student level, and impact on the image of the professions in New Brunswick. The recipient will be notified by telephone and in writing.

Presentation

The Outstanding Student Award will be presented at an appropriate Branch function or during the Annual Meeting in a manner in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

Award

Trophy engraved with recipient's name.

Promotion

Award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by APEGNB which may include:

- Pictures of award recipient and biography printed in annual magazine
- Pictures of award recipient to appear in newsletter—Engenuity
- Coverage of award recipient in New Brunswick newspapers

Commencement

The **Outstanding Student Award** has never been presented. The award does not have to be conferred on an annual basis.

- B **Role Model** (35%)—This section should include examples of how the nominee is an effective communicator and role model within the engineering/geoscience student community. This section should also include evidence of the nominee's strong leadership skills, professionalism and ethics through active community involvement; active participation in engineering/geoscience student societies, institutes or other professional bodies, or in activities that enhance the image of engineering/geoscience students and the professions in New Brunswick; and work done to increase public awareness of the career opportunities that exist in engineering/geoscience.
- C **Personal and General Information**—Education, publications, honours, decorations and other relevant information.
