

Support of Women in Engineering Award

General

The **Support of Women in Engineering Award** is presented to an outstanding engineer(s) who, in the opinion of the Association, through their engineering and career achievements, has demonstrated noteworthy support for women in engineering and has established a benchmark of engineering excellence.

Nomination

Nominations for the Support of Women in Engineering Award must be submitted to the Awards Committee in writing on the appropriate APEGNB form and must be supported by at least two (2) APEGNB members.

Eligibility Criteria

The nominee must be a professional engineer registered in good standing with APEGNB.*

**Members of the APEGNB Council are not considered eligible for the award until a period of at least six months has elapsed from the completion date of their term of office.*

Selection

The Awards Committee will consider each nominee on his/her merits and make recommendations to Council on the conferring of the Award. Consideration is given to leadership in engineering, business or industry, the education sector, provincially or nationally, and recognition as a role model for women entering or in the practice of engineering. The recipient will be notified by telephone and in writing.

Presentation

The Award will be presented at an appropriate function during the Annual Meeting in a manner in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

Award

Trophy engraved with recipient's name.

Promotion

Award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by APEGNB which may include:

- Pictures of award recipient and biography printed in annual magazine
- Pictures of award recipient to appear in newsletter–Engenuity
- Coverage of award recipient in New Brunswick newspapers

Commencement

The **Support of Women in Engineering Award** has never been presented. The award does not have to be conferred on an annual basis.

On additional pages (not to exceed 10 pages), please provide information about the nominee according to the categories listed at right. All categories must be addressed and accompanied if necessary by documentation describing the work and achievements of the nominee which would qualify the nominee for the award. Additional documentation should be as concise as possible

- A **Recognition as Role Model** (70%) – This section should include evidence of the profile and visibility of the nominee within the engineering profession, business or industry, the education sector, or nationally/internationally. This section should also include evidence of the nominee's recognition as a role model for women entering, or in the practice of engineering.
- B **Work-Related Achievements** (10%) – This section should include evidence of engineering excellence, and recognition of achievement within engineering, business or industry, or education sector that has set a benchmark for engineers to strive for.
- C **Service to the Profession** (10%) – This section should include evidence of the nominee's efforts to increase public education and understanding the role of engineering and professional engineers in New Brunswick. This section should also include evidence of the nominee's active participation in professional associations, societies, institutes, etc.
- D **Service to the Community** (10%) – This section should include evidence of active participation in commissions, voluntary organizations, community organizations and other paid or unpaid work beyond the professions.
- E **Personal and General Information**—Education, publications, directorships, honours, decorations and other relevant information.
