

Young Professional Achievement Award

General

The **Young Professional Achievement Award** is given to a young outstanding professional engineer/geoscientist who has carried out major engineering/geoscience achievements in or on behalf of New Brunswick. The Award recognizes exceptional technical achievements in his/her chosen fields.

Nomination

Nominations for the Young Professional Achievement Award must be submitted to the Awards Committee in writing on the appropriate APEGNB form and must be supported by at least two (2) APEGNB members.

Eligibility Criteria

The nominee must meet the following requirements:

- Be a professional engineer or geoscientist registered in good standing with APEGNB.*
- Be no older than 35 years of age as of the date the award is presented. (February)

**Members of the APEGNB Council are not considered eligible for an award until a period of at least six months has elapsed from the completion date of their term of office.*

Selection

The Awards Committee will consider each nominee on his/her merits and make recommendations to Council on the conferring of the Award. Consideration is given to the nominee's engineering/geoscience excellence within the professions, business or industry, or education sector. Recipients will be notified by telephone and in writing.

Presentation

The Award will be presented at an appropriate Branch function or during the Annual Meeting in a manner in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

Award

Trophy engraved with recipient's name.

Promotion

Award recipients agree to standard publicity notification arranged by APEGNB which may include:

- Pictures of award recipient and biography printed in annual magazine
- Pictures of award recipient to appear in newsletter—Engenuity
- Coverage of award recipient in New Brunswick newspapers

Commencement

The **Young Professional Achievement Award** has never been presented. The award does not have to be conferred on an annual basis.
