


The Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL) and the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of New Brunswick (APEGNB), agreed to jointly complete a geoscientist salary survey. Many members, employers, and those considering a career in geosciences have expressed an interest in obtaining current statistics on geoscientist salaries in the Atlantic region. It has been three years since members were asked to participate in the last survey.

The 2018 salary survey was conducted and compiled by ClearPicture Corp. This year 350 members were asked to participate in the survey, with 110 responding for a 31% participation rate. Only the aggregated data has been presented in this report. Individual members data will be kept confidential and ClearPicture Corp. will not share that data with anyone.

The mean, median, lower and upper quartiles were calculated using the midpoint of each of the salary ranges. Where the mean is the average, median is the 50th percentile, lower quartile is the 25th percentile and the upper quartile is the 75th percentile.








#### Salary by Membership Status










## Salary by Gender












#### Salary by Post-Graduate Studies






#### Salary by Post-Graduate Degree



#### Salary by Sector of Employment









#### Vacation by Employment Sector






