

## 2021 EARTH RING CEREMONY... Deadline April 30

**The 2021 Earth Ring Ceremony will be held virtually this year in the early evening May 17 or 18<sup>th</sup>.**

Any practicing New Brunswick geoscientists without Earth Rings wishing to become obligated and receive a ring are welcome to participate. Please download a registration form from the APEGNB website and place your ring order (3 or 4mm Sterling Silver rings are \$70 plus HST). The ring is worn on the smallest (pinkie) finger of your working hand. Please have your finger sized by a jeweler before ordering. The Earth Ring is a symbol of the professional oath you are asked to take during the ceremony and as such **attendance is mandatory in order to receive your ring.**

To take part in the ceremony and receive an Earth Ring, you must have obtained a geoscience degree from a recognized university or be a practicing geoscientist in New Brunswick.

**The deadline for orders/registration is 4:00 pm, April, 30.**
