

JOCELYNE ROY-VIENNEAU UNDERGRADUATE ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP FOR WOMEN

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of New Brunswick (APEGNB) has created the *Jocelyne Roy-Vienneau Undergraduate Engineering Scholarships for Women*, valued at \$3000 in honour of New Brunswick's first female engineer Lieutenant Governor and in support of the Association's commitment of working towards increasing the number of women in the engineering profession.

Two scholarships are awarded each year to female engineering undergraduate students entering their 2nd year or higher of full-time study: one (1) at the University of New Brunswick (Fredericton or Saint John) and one (1) at l'Université de Moncton.

The successful candidate will be a leader in their community and act as a role model to other young women to encourage them to pursue a career in engineering.

The scholarship recipients must agree to having their image and or name used in APEGNB materials promoting Women in Engineering and may be asked to give a presentation to middle or high school girls about why they chose to study engineering.

DEADLINE

Applications are accepted until 11:59pm on September 30th and will be awarded in October.

ELIGIBILITY

- Female undergraduate student in second year (or above) of full-time study.
- In good academic standing.
- Applicants will be scored on leadership, volunteer activity, and academic standing.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- 1) A student is eligible for one APEGNB scholarship each academic year. If you are successful in more than one APEGNB scholarship competitions, you will only receive the award with the highest value.
- 2) To ensure the scholarship assists as many NB female students as possible, previously successful applicants who still qualify as per the criteria above are not eligible to reapply.
- 3) Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
